EXPLANATION.

Each Parish has been taken from its head, or farthest point from the sea-shore; every plantation put by rotation as they occur, coming from one to the other, according to their locality, on the Prairies or Bayous in each Parish. The River Parishes are so arranged as to commence first on the right side, next upon the left side of the Mississippi River. West and East Feliciana and East Baton Rouge are all on the left side of the Mississippi River, one single plantation excepted: W. B. Turnbull's, on Red River Island. Pointe Coupée and West Baton Rouge are entirely on the right side of the Mississippi. The Parishes of Assumption and Lafourche Interior are exactly as the River Parishes, right and left. This is as far as sea-faring vessels go, and the distances are given. Please, however, note that sea vessels go into the Bayou Teche as far up New Iberia, where great quantities of Sugar and Molasses are shipped and cleared at the Franklin Customhouse, in the Parish of St. Mary, direct to the Atlantic markets.

NOTE.—The parishes of Jefferson, Orleans, St. Bernard and Plaquemine have the New Orleans post-office placed opposite them, still in addressing persons living in said parishes it would be better to name the parish in which such person resides.

THE CANE CULTURE.

The Cane culture in this State is well known to be exposed to certain unfavorable vicissitudes to which it is not liable in more southern latitudes, and hence its past history presents remarkable fluctuations in the product, as will be seen by the annexed statement, which gives the crop of each year, from 1828 to 1861, inclusive—a period of thirty-two years :

INTRODUCTION.

At the date of my last annual report, 20th February, 1861, the Sugar interest of Louisiana was prosperous, and the prospect of a good crop was most encouraging. The ground was well prepared, a great deal of Cane had been planted, and the weather was mild and favorable. The fine condition of the Seed Cane, and the satisfactory state of the soil, with the quantity of land under cultivation, induced me to entertain flattering hopes of a large yield ; a combination of favorable circumstances seemed to confirm these hopes, and to promise very satisfactory results. These gratifying prospects continued in a great measure throughout the Spring and Summer, and the Planters of Louisiana were enabled to commence grinding at a remarkably early period. The last season presents quite a contrast as compared with that of 1860, which was very dry during the Spring ; excessively stormy in the late Summer and early Fall, causing very great destruction in many sections of Louisiana, embracing the most productive Sugar regions of the State; in some localities submerging entire plantations with sea water, and in others destroying not only the Cane, but also Sugar-Houses and Furgeries, which were blown down, doing great and serious damage to machinery and other property.

The season for grinding was most favorable and proved unusually propitious, and a very large crop was realized, although the yield of the Cane was not liberal at first, some Planters having commenced grinding at an earlier period of the year than ever before known in Louisiana. Could the Planters have foreseen so mild and pleasant a winter, so favorable a season for taking off their crops, a materially larger yield would have been produced. It has been an established custom for years, with many Planters to windrow their Cane in November, which in many previous seasons proved of great advantage to them, but this season, the result was very unsatisfactory, some plantations having scarcely made more than half the yield they probably would have realized had they not windrowed.

As to the crop now under cultivation, I regret to state that the general promise is most unfavorable. As usual a large crop was aimed at, but owing to the numerous disastrous crevasses which have inundated a large portion of many of the most productive Sugar Parishes of the State, and the disasters attending the war, the crop will fall very far short of

that of last year, even under the most favorable auspices during the balance of the season. A considerable portion of the Cane-growing country has been disturbed, while some plantations are left almost entirely bare of working hands.

INTRODUCTION.

A la date de mon desnier rapport annuel, le 20 Février 1861, l'intérêt sucrier de la Louisiane était prospère et la perspective d'une bonne récolte, des plus encourageantes. La terre avait été bien préparée, une grande quantité de cannes plantée, et le temps était doux et favorable. Le bon état du plant de cannes ainsi que celui de la grande étendue de terres en culture, me faisait espérer une grande récolte; une suite de circonstances favorables semblait confirmer notre espoir, et promettre d'heureux résultats. Cette perspective encourageante se prolongea pendant le printemps et l'été, et les Planteurs de la Louisiane purent de bonne heure commencer la roulaison. La dernière saison offre un contraste à celle de 1860, qui fut très-sèche au printemps, orageuse à la fin de l'été, et au commencement de l'automne, ce qui causa des dégâts considérables dans les principales régions sucrières de l'Etat, l'eau de mer submergeant des plantations dans certaines localités et détruisant dans d'autres non seulement la canne, mais encore les sucreries et purgeries, ainsi que les moulins et machines qu'elle contenait.

La saison fut très-favorable à la roulaison, et l'on fit une belle récolte, quoique le rendement de la Canne ne fut pas considérable en premier lieu; quelques planteurs ayant commencé beaucoup plutôt que jamais en Louisiane. S'ils avaient pu prévoir un hiver aussi doux et une saison aussi propice, la récolte eût été bien plus considérable. Depuis longtemps beaucoup de Planteurs avaient adopté l'usage d'entasser leur Cannes dans les sillons en Novembre, et s'en étaient bien trouvés jusqu'alors; mais cette fois ce moyen n'eut pas le même succès, et sur quelques habitations on fit à peine la moitié de ce qu'on aurait fait si on ne l'avait pas adopté.

Quant à la présente récolte, elle se présente sous un aspect très-défavorable. Comme à l'ordinaire, on a beaucoup planté. Mais l'inondation causée par les crevasses dans plusieurs des plus fortes paroisses sucrières de l'Etat et les désastres de la guerre réduiront la récolte actuelle à un chiffre bien inférieur à celui de la dernière, même sous les auspices les plus favorables pour le reste de la saison. Une grande partie du pays

cultivé en cannes a été dérangé et sur plusieurs habitations, on
manque presqu'entièrement de bras pour la culture.

The above figures briefly illustrate the Commerce of the Country in this pro-
duct of the Cane for the past year. It will be seen that the total receipts of
Foreign Raw Sugars into the United States (California and Oregon excepted)
for the year ending December 31, 1861, were 242,908 tons, against receipts in
1860 of 241,533 tons. The quantity of Foreign withdrawn for consumption
in 1861, was 241,420 tons, against 236,350 tons in 1860; while the total Con-
sumption of Foreign and Domestic, Cane Sugar in 1861, was 263,819 tons,
against a Consumption in 1860 of 415,281 tons, being a decrease in the Consump-
tion of Foreign of 18 70-100 per cent., and in Foreign and Domestic 12 39-100
per cent. These results reflect in a measure, the severe blow which commerce
has received from the war; had it not been for this, we should, beyond a doubt,
have been able to record a larger business in this article of food, than we have
ever before noticed.

GENERAL REMARKS.

In my report of the crop of each plantation, I have, as much
as it has been in my power, extended the crops in actual
hogsheads, and paid no regard whatever to either the quantity
in pounds, value or quality of their contents, as every one is
aware that they differ materially in all these particulars. But
very few planters are opposed to this method of reporting their
crops, and these are to be found amongst those working by
the different new processes, whilst others reproach me with
wishing to swell the extent of the crop of Louisiana. I should
like to have them reflect on the difference it would make in
my report if I was to call a hogshead 1000 pounds, as some
of them would have me to do. No one could understand
where so many hogsheads of Sugar had been found by me,
when no one else could see them. Let it be well understood
that the different plantations of Louisiana furnish to the com-
merce of the country, hogsheads of considerable difference, as
well in value as in weight and quality of contents. It is well
known that our planters do not make hogsheads of the same
size, and there is a wide margin in some of them.

In making my estimate of the total amount of the crop in
pounds, I have concluded, after due investigation, to adopt the
ratio of 1150 pounds per hogshead, as being the proper esti-
mate upon the gross amount of the total crop—the Sugar
having been generally of a good quality.

The product of seventy plantations, worked by the vacuum
and other new processes, and amounting to 58,469 hogsheads,
I class as a distinct and separate article, some being refined,
clarified, etc, and all these planters working their cistern
Sugars, and a few even some of their Molasses, which are
returned in their crops as Sugar, although oftentimes of a
rather inferior quality.

I have found, that of the Sugar-houses in operation in this State, some 1291 of them have given an aggregate production of 459,410 hogsheads Sugar, weighing, according to my estimate, 528,321,500 pounds of all sorts, including the cistern bottoms, 1027 of the plantations being worked by steam and 264 by horse power.

The production of Molasses has been as large as the previous season ; I have, therefore, thought that about 70 gallons per thousand pounds sugar would be a proper estimate ; say about 36,982,505 gallons, against 18,414,550 the year previous.

OBSERVATIONS GÉNÉRALES.

Dans mon rapport de la production de chaque habitation, je n'ai qu'autant qu'il a été en mon pouvoir porté le chiffre de chaque une dans mes colonnes qu'en boucauts réels, tels qu'ils se comportent, et n'ai nullement eu égard à la quantité de livres, ni à la valeur, pas plus qu'à la qualité de leur contenu, chacun sachant très bien qu'il existe de très grandes variations dans toutes ces particularités. Il n'y a que fort peu de planteurs qui soient opposés à cette manière de rapporter leurs récoltes, et ceux-ci se trouvent parmi les nouveaux procédés, pendant que d'autres sont sous l'impression que mon désir serait de chercher à enfler la récolte de la Louisiane. J'aimerais à les voir réfléchir et considérer la différence que cela ferait dans mon relevé de la récolte, si j'établissais une moyenne de mille livres au boucaut, comme quelques-uns d'eux voudraient que je fisse ; on pourrait avec raison demander où je trouve autant de boucauts de sucre, que personne ne verrait que moi-même. Je désire donc, qu'il soit bien entendu que je prétends dire que les habitations sucrières de la Louisiane fournissent au commerce du pays des boucauts de sucre de toutes capacités, ainsi que de toutes qualités. *Du reste, chacun sait fort bien que nos planteurs ont le droit de faire leurs boucauts de la grandeur qui leur convient.*

En faisant mon estimé du total de la récolte en livres, j'ai pensé d'après mes recherches faites, qu'il serait rationnel d'adopter un average de 1150 livres par boucaut, sur la totalité de la récolte. Les sucres ayant été généralement de bonne qualité.

Le produit de 70 habitations exploitées par le vacuum ou nouveaux procédés, se montant à 58,469 boucauts, je classe comme un article à part, tel que sucre raffiné, clarifié, etc., etc. Les propriétaires de ces différentes manufactures me rapportent

dans leurs récoltes, les fonds de citernes, et quelques uns, même du sucre de mélasses, parfois d'assez mauvaise qualité.

J'ai trouvé parmi les sucreries en opération dans l'Etat, que 1,291 ont produit 459,410 boucauts sucre, pesant ensemble 528,321,500 livres, de toutes sortes y incluant les fonds de citernes selon l'estimé que j'en ai fait; sur 1027 des susdites habitations on se sert de vapeur, et sur 264 de chevaux comme force motrice.

Le produit des mélasses a été aussi abondant que dans l'année précédente, j'ai, en conséquence, pensé qu'environ 70 gallons par mille livres de sucre serait un estimé convenable, c'est-à-dire, 36,982,505 gallons, contre 18,414,550 l'année dernière.
