## INTRODUCTION

PIERRE ANTOINE CHAMPOMIER was the author of a series of statistical reports entitled "Statement of Sugar Made In Louisiana." According to the 1850 United States Census of Orleans Parish, Mr. Champomier was born in France about 1794. Sometime after 1867 he returned to the home of his ancestors in France where he lived for the remainder of his life. Mr. Champomier contributed more to the preservation of the history of the Louisiana Sugar Planter than any other individual of his own time.

The planters represented in Champomier's statements ranged from the very wealthy planter with thousands of acres of land, to the very poor planter with only a few hundred acres of land. In later editions, he gives listings of sugar planters in the south eastern counties of the State of Texas, such as Brazoria County, Fort Bend County and Matagord County. Champomier's trade reports provided valuable insight of the direction of the sugar industry.

In 1834 through 1838 P. A. Champomier is listed as a merchant and a produce broker in partnership, "Champomier & Giraud, brokers, located at 6 1/2 New Levee." It appears that in 1841 he is no longer partner to P. A. Giraud. His business address changes many times, beginning in 1843 with "40 Old Levee near Custom House," in 1846 "46 1/2 Old Levee," in 1854 "10 New Customhouse," and finally in 1860 "13 New Customhouse." (New Orleans City Directories, 1834 - 1867, located with the "The Historic New Orleans Collection, 533 Royal Street, New Orleans, Louisiana")

His choice of dwelling from 1834 to 1867 was within the Vieux Carre, with the last known address of 71 Conti in 1867. (Ibid., 1834-1867, Directories) The Vieux Carre Survey shows ownership of 71 Conti in 1867 as Pierre Antoine Geraud, possibly the produce broker partner of Champomier in 1834-38. (The Historic New Orleans Collection, 533 Royal Street, New Orleans, Louisiana)

Existing information concerning Mr. Champomier is extremely rare. One would think that several biographies concerning Mr. Champomier would be available for the interest of the public and the genealogical community - such is not the case. It is a possibility that the only written tribute to P. A. Champomier exist by way of an article entitled "First of Sugar Trade Journals Issued at New Orleans in Forties." (Sunday May 8, 1910, "Times-Democrat", New Orleans, La., Louisiana State Library, Baton Rouge, Louisiana) The image of Mr. Champomier on the adjacent page was reproduced from a copy of the original. ## INTRODUCTION

In the early issues of his trade journals, P. A. Champomier had difficulties with the spelling of non-French names. He would also give the English names the French equivalent. Edwin would be written as Edouard, Lawrence as Laurent and so on. Within his later editions, he apparently becomes better acquainted with the surnames of the planters.

P. A. Champomier's "Statement of Sugar Made In Louisiana" was published continuously for nineteen years, 1844-1863. We can view these trade journals today not only as statistical reports on the sugar planter of that period, but also as census reports yielding valuable information concerning our ancestors. Years of His Life to the Interests of Sugar and the  
Planters of Sugar - Facts of Conflagration,  
Crevasse, and Hurricane Recorded in the  
Annual Pamphlets.

In one of Mrs. Ripley's charming letters, in a recent issue of The Times-Democrat, reference was made to that fine old - time boat, La Belle Creole, and to M. Champomier, "le vieux Champomier," as he was then known to the traveling public who saw him making the rounds of the sugar plantations.

Mr. P. A. Champomier was one of the most interesting characters of that early time, and has left to New Orleans a collection of "Annuals" which are not only unique in themselves but which are invaluable records of the fifteen years before the war. No student of Louisiana history or Louisiana romance can afford to overlook them. It is not probable that Monsieur Champomier ever regarded his own work in that light. He was merely a lonely old man, deeply interested in the sugar industry, and willingly giving his time and attention to gathering statistics which would not have been collected in any other way. That he did this work with such great thoroughness that his annual statistics concerning the sugar crop was also a directory of the sugar parishes was quite beyond his calculations; yet such was the result of his journeyings, and one may take up his old "Statement" of any years in those fifteen years and find who lived on every plantation in twenty-three parishes during that year, as well as all the calamities each one suffered from fire or overflow or drought. It is a wonderful collection, this first of the sugar trade journals.

There are relatives of M. Champomier still living in New Orleans, notably Mr. A. A. Lelong of the Citizens Bank, who has many reminiscences concerning the old statistician, who was Mr. Lelong's great uncle. For a long time they two were the only ones of the family in this country, and the bond between them was nat-

urally close. When the war began, and M. Champomier was too old and feeble to go to the front, he was none the less one of the most ardent of confederates, and when his great - nephew enlisted the old man went with him to the station and carried his "carpet-bag" as a pathetic evidence that he was longing to do something for the cause he loved. After the war Mr. Champomier returned to France, Mr. Lelong accompanying him to New York and seeing him safe on board ship. He died in France not long after in the home of his ancestors. But he had rendered a lasting service to the country of his adoption in publishing these fifteen sugar "Statements."

Never before nor since were statistics gathered with so much personal exertion and such direct personal interest. In that splendid little passenger boat of the old times, La Belle Creole, he did much of his traveling. People who remember the Belle Creole relate one fact that satisfies to the full one's wildest dreams of luxury, however much it may do damage to one's ideas of sensible produce. On La Belle Creole, they say, no one ever washed dishes - after a meal they were simply thrown overboard and a new supply brought out for the next meal. This tradition may well be taken with many grains of salt, but at any rate the fact is established that the Creole was a fine and luxurious boat, in which people went traveling to and from the city after the comfortable, leisurely manner of the old times.

It was by way of this and other boats then, that M. Champomier made most of his investigations: zigzagged up and down the rivers and bayous in the sugar district, visiting every plantation on both sides of all the streams and getting the figures at first hand from the planters themselves. The result was a sugar trade journal which he published every spring, and which he called "Statement of the Sugar Crop Made in Louisiana." Every year, from 1844 to 1859, the statement appeared, with its definite and personal information for the planters themselves and for the factors and merchants who dealt with them.

#### FIRST OF THE STATEMENTS

The first of the annual statements, issued in 1844, is a thin pamphlet, bound in blue paper, and seeming altogether out of proportion to the \$5 that was charged for it. One learns from its unexpected details, such as the fact that Dr. Brashear of St Mary parish, twenty five miles below Franklin, had eighty hogshead of sugar "burnt" that year out of a crop of ninety - five hogsheads, and the reader is worried still over that ancient loss, and wonders how it happened. The total crop of the year is set down at 191,824 hogsheads, one hogshead being estimated at 1000 pounds. A note at the close says:

"It is to be remarked that the cistern bottoms resulting from the crop have not been reboiled by the planters, as heretofore has been the case; they have been brought up by the refiners at higher rates than the planters could realize by working them over. This item is estimated to be equivalent to 5 per cent addition to the number of hogsheads of sugar, and would swell the crop to full 200,000. A large quantity of cane has been sold in the field to make plant for new plantations, a considerable quantity was lost by overflow in the summer, and some for want of fuel to work it. There has not been the usual quantity of molasses made in proportion to that of sugar, owing probably to the cane having acquired a higher degree of maturity."

How strange it is to read of that old overflow of sixty - six years ago, and of the scarcity of fuel, and of all the little details that were matters of moment in the days when La Belle Creole was young!

On one of the yellowing pages of this first "Statement" one finds that Valcour Aime, visited so long ago by a gay little girl who is now Mrs. Ripley, had a refinery on his plantation, fifty-seven miles above New Orleans, while the next plantation above and the next above that belonged to Romans- those Romans who came crowding in to see Tante Lise.

As evidence of the manner in which M. Champomier wrote his old parish directory, one finds that in Jefferson parish, that year, on the right side of the river, were Joseph Dusseau, seventeen miles above the city; Edouard Fortier & Co., fifteen miles; Eugene Fortier, part of the same plantation; Mrs. Waggaman, thirteen miles; Lucien Labranche, ten; Camille Zeringue; eight; Harang & Fazende, six; Laurent Millaudon, five; Verlon Degruys & Fazende, four; while on the left side were Butler Kenner, seventeen miles; Minor Kenner, sixteen; Rene Trudeau, fifteen; Pierre Sauvet, fourteen; J. Soniat Dufassat, twelve; Lacistiere & Laberre, eight; Arnault Freres, seven.

In St. Bernard, on the right, or Algiers side of the river, were Pierre Hoa, Cazimir Lacoste, J. B. Lepretre, Dussuau, Delacroix, and Caliste Villere; while on the left were Gabriel Villere, C. Chiapella, J. Hewett, Mrs. A. Phillippon, L. D. Beauregard, M. and A. Ducros, B. Poydras, Marine & Fagot (Terre - au-Bouef), Laurent Millaudon, Estate of Jorda, Jaques Toutant, Pierre Reaud, Mrs. G. Olivier, Mrs. A. Regio, Proctor Bros., and Michaud (Chef Menteur).

## FROM 1849-50

The numbers from 1849-50 inclusive were afterward published in a neat volume, which forms part of the old history of Louisiana. One finds all the way through the quaint little book those interesting details and little personal notes that give an unexpected touch of pathos to this volume which set out to be nothing more than a collection of figures. In 1849, for instance, in Rapides parish, "The loss by the overflow of Red river didn't destroy less than 2900 hogshds. of sugar. It is a low estimate." Doubtless there were hard times in Rapides that long - gone year on account of the overflow. The many bayous of Avoyelles have their lists of plantations and their number of hogsheds; Bayou Boeuf and Huffpower, Bayou Clair and Bayou Rouge Prairie and Bayou Deglaise - not a plantation owner omitted on either side of all the bayous. Here is William R. Barrow of West Feliciana parish with 450 hogsheds lost by fire, and here and there, all down the pages, is an eloquent asterisk with "lost by overflow." A note of West Baton Rouge parish in that year of 1849 says: "There have been three crevasses in this parish the past season, which did not destroy less than 5500 hogsheds. The first which gave way last winter has broken again this season, and will destroy more all the crops in the upper part of the parish. The damage to the crop going into the ground will be very great, and the loss nearly as large as that suffered by the present crop."

One feels yet the calamity of that year for West Baton Rouge, through the hearts that ached over the destruction of their crops in that old year have almost all ceased to ache.

There was a crevasse in Ascension parish that year which the planters themselves stopped, after the loss of 1200 hogsheds. In Jefferson parish on both sides there was great loss by crevasses, and the year must have been a discouraging one through all the sugar country; yet so many new plantations had been opened that the crop reached 247,923 hogsheds.

In the report made in the season of 1850 - 1851 M. Champomier says in his preface that it has cost him "the most onerous labors and a travel of upward of ninety days in the interior parishes of the State," and that while never fairly remunerated, the promises and hopes of the future have alone sustained him.

## A BULL REPORT

"The importance of correct knowledge in regard to the crops can not be questioned," he says. "It can be thus inferred what

may be expected in prices; what another year will develop; how we are comparing with other sugar countries," etc. M. Champomier never fails to capitalize "Sugar." "The minute and accurate statistics of each estate," he continues, "informing as they do planters of the movements and results of each other, must stimulate individual industry, enterprise and emulation, and can only be objected to by those who would abolish the whole principle of census taking, whether Federal, State or parish."

M. Champomier further asks the co-operation of the planters in sending in their own reports, "otherwise he must obtain the facts by the most laborious process of personal application and travel. This he has not refrained from doing, nor omitted any pains which could insure the greatest certainty. Slight errors, after all, may have happened."

Still a wider field, he acknowledges, was open before him. "Many of the planters," he says, have desired this report to cover a wider field, and include the number of acres of land in cultivation in cane, corn, etc.; the produce of each, number of effective hands, mules, horses, etc. These facts would be very useful, and an attempt would be cheerfully made to give them were it the wish of the planters, though in this way the labors and difficulties of the publication would be immensely increased."

So speaks M. Champomier, standing away back in the nineteenth century, and quite ready to combine in himself the offices of the Census Bureau, the Board of Trade and the Cotton Exchange, all in one. For some reason the suggestion was never carried out, or we would be able to see how many able-bodied slaves worked on each and every plantation; and how many mules and horses were driven afield when "plow-time" began.

Again that year there was widespread destruction from overflows. In Pointe Coupee alone there were seven crevasses by which the crops on many plantations were completely obliterated. The statement recalls that the last spring has been very cold and rainy, and then that the entire sugar section was without rain from the beginning of July to the very last of the grinding season. "Nearly every planter had to haul water to grind, some from a very considerable distance. Some had to windrow their cane and wait for rain to fill their reservoirs before making sugar."

#### GREAT BONNET CARRE CREVASSE

The Bonnet Carre crevasse that year destroyed not less than 5000 hogsheads of sugar in the parishes of St. John the Baptist, St. Charles and Jefferson. Finally there were early and severe



frosts which hurt the crop very materially. As a result, M. Champomier says: "There are but few new plantations preparing for the next crop, the improvement in the price of cotton having deterred many from entering upon sugar who were nearly ready to embark in that culture. How long it will be before they cultivate sugar, time only will show."

In the report for the season of 1851-52 M. Champomier ran for the first time what might have been called "advertising columns," and the following issues contained a few notices of this or that business enterprise. It does not appear, however, that he ever cared for "ads," and it is altogether probable that the advertisers ran him down and besought him to print their various business notices. The fact of all these is a "fullpage" ad. of that wonderful old publication, "DeBow's Review, which was "published monthly, at New Orleans, at 22 Exchange place."

#### SEVERE WINTERS

In the "Statement" of the next year we read of the unusually severe winter, and a quotation is given from a recent publication by Dr. E. H. Barton, a long-time observer of the weather. In this extract Dr. Barton refers to a still colder winter, that of 1835, when on the 8th of February the mercury went down to 15 degrees, and ice was half an inch thick on Bayou St. John. and even to a winter colder yet, when on Feb. 16, 1823, the mercury stood at 10 degrees, and boys were skating on ponds "about the then levee, where there are now four-story buildings."

In the introduction to the report for the season of 1853-1854 there is an item that is filled with the pathos of that sorrowful and calamitous time. "Owing to the sickness which prevailed throughout the South during the summer and fall, the quantity of wood cut and sawed was very limited; so much so; in fact, that many planters have had to pay as high as \$5.50 per cord for it."

Everyone has read of that great yellow fever, but it remained for this old book of statistics to give a new picture of its horrors; the picture of every wanted occupation being given up, even in remote country districts; of the wood-choppers letting the ax lie idle, while they shivered in dread of the coming of the plague.

So the wonderful old record goes on; an early frost one year, a hurricane another, crevasses, dry weather, too much rain, conflagrations; the old chronicler entering into the subject with such sympathy as never before did any man bring to the compiling of statistics. In the last of all the reports he gives an account

of the famous Bell crevasse, April 11, 1858, above Algiers, the effect of which was emphasized by the crevasses at the LaBranche plantation, twenty-five miles higher up. Old residents of Gretna will tell you that the water came up in their town within half a block of the levee, on the under side, during that memorable crevasse.

It was the last crevasse M. Champomier was ever to record; the closing of his years of labor for the sugar interests of Louisiana. What experiences he must have had during those years of journeying back and forth, up and down the water courses; the years when he became a familiar figure at every plantation, stepping down the gangplank of La Belle Creole, note book in hand! What friendships he must have formed with those planters, in the days when plantation life was at its royal best, and every planter kept open house. What jubilations he must have had with them when they came to the city, and he entertained them in his turn at his beautiful home, or at the old St. Louis Hotel- in the days when the planters made their princely journeys to New Orleans! They all belong to the old times; M. Champomier and the old planters and La Belle Creole, long since gone on her last journey.

NOTA. - It is to be remarked that the cistern bottoms resulting from this crop have not been reboiled by the planters as heretofore has been the case, they have been bought up by the refiners at higher rates than the planters could realize by working them over, this item is estimated to be equivalent to 5 per cent addition to the number of Hhds. sugar and would swell the crop to full 200,00 Hhds.

A large quantity of cane has been sold in the field to make plant for new plantations, a considerable quantity was lost by overflow in the summer and some for want of fuel to work it.



There has not been the usual quantity of molasses made in proportion to that of sugar, owing probably to the cane having acquired a higher degree of maturity, and it is supposed the average yield has not exceeded 45 galls per 1000 lbs sugar, or in round numbers about 9,000,000 glls.

It will be observed from the foregoing statement that there are in operation in this State 762 sugar mills, of which 408 are worked by steam engines and 354 by horse power, the number of planters about 900, some of the smaller estates joining their neighbors in one sugar house.

There will be a large increase of sugar plantations in this State within the next two years, preparations are making for full 60 or 70, the low prices of cotton having induced many growers of this staple in the parishes of Pointe Coupee, West Baton Rouge, Iberville, St. Landry, Opelousas, & c., to turn their attention to sugar.

## REMARKS

Nota.---I have thought proper in this recapitulation to include the Cistern sugar, estimated at 5 00 on the crop, believing that a large portion of it will be re-boiled by the Planters themselves, as the Refiners last year lost money at the prices they and besides it is really sugar and should therefore be estimated in the crop.

The Molasses, as was the case the last year, is generally estimated as less than usual, but whilst the old plantations have made less than usual, the new ones have given a fuller yield, and it will therefore not be correct to estimate it at less than 45 gallons per 1000 lbs. sugar, or upwards of 9 millions of gallons.

Though, with extended culture and new plantations on the river and Bayou Lafourche, the parishes have yielded less than last season, with a few exceptions all planters have fallen short, while the Attakapas Parishes have produced considerably more than last season.

The early frost has probably injured the crop to the extent of 15000 Hhds, and some crops have been entirely lost by not being ready in time to grind; one large crop by the Sugar house being burnt when just begun making sugar.

Since completing my work I have learned of the existence of several Sugar houses having made sugar the past season, but as it was too late for me to visit them, I have concluded not to notice them for the present.

I find there will be in full operation in 1847-8, 1240 Sugar houses owned by 2077 separate Proprietors or heads of families; the produce this last year from 955 sugar mills is 186,650 Hdds, or 207,337 Hhds. of one thousand pounds nett; that there are 204 sugar mills that will produce in 1846, '47 and 81 that will produce in 1847-8, but fully expect the number will be still further increased, as there are such large bodies of sugar lands on the River and Bayous that only require capital to place them under culture, and there is no doubt the culture of the cane can be extended further west, and I believe the day is not far distant when our Red River Steam Packets will be equally loaded with Sugar and Molasses as well as Cotton, as our Bayou Sarah Packets now are.

Of the 1240 Sugar mills which will be in full operation in 1847-8, about 630 will be by steam power and 610 by horse power, but the former will rapidly increase, as good many Planters now working by horse power have already contracted for their Engines besides the new Planters that are generally speaking preparing for Steam Engines.

Had my Statement been deferred until the last of April, I have no doubt, it would be ascertained that the crop is larger than I made it, as I am sorry to say that some parties interested who view a large crop in a different light to what I do have endeavoured to lead me into error on that subject, though I owe my thanks to many who have assisted me in obtaining correct information.
